## **Announcement of Our 2026 Scholarship Program for University of California, Davis, Undergraduate Students Who Volunteer at UC Davis-Affiliated Free Clinics**

- **Awards and Eligibility**

- The Sacramento Chapter of Physicians for Social Responsibility (PSR/Sacramento) will be awarding at least \$10,000 in scholarships distributed among at least 10 UC Davis undergraduate students in 2026. All UC Davis undergraduate students who have volunteered over the past academic year at one of the UC Davis-affiliated free clinics are eligible to apply for one of the scholarships.

- **Application Process**

- To apply for a scholarship, students must complete the online application form that can be accessed by [clicking on this link](#). Application form elements include:
  - Student's name, mailing address, email address, and phone number
  - The name of the free clinic(s) at which the student has volunteered; an estimate of the number of hours that the student has worked; and a summary of the role(s) the student has played at the free clinic(s)
  - A statement concerning financial need
  - An essay of 500 words or fewer describing the student's future career and educational goals; how the experience in volunteering at the free clinic(s) has shaped these goals; and how the student's goals intersect with one or more of PSR/Sacramento's focus areas, which include:
    - Ensuring universal access to high quality health care for everyone in the United States without regard to income level, insurance coverage, immigration status, race, religion, gender identification, or other socio-economic factors
    - Reducing the threat of nuclear war and other forms of war and militarism, including militarization of domestic law enforcement

- Protecting our natural environment
  - Promoting social justice within our own country and abroad
  - Reducing interpersonal violence, including gun violence
- A transcript documenting college courses and grades
- The deadline for students to apply for a scholarship is Sunday, March 29, 2026.
- **Selection of Scholarship Recipients and Amount of Scholarship Awards**
  - The PSR/Sacramento Steering Committee will establish a panel of PSR members to choose scholarship recipients based on a combination of factors included in the scholarship application.
  - At least 10 scholarships of \$1,000 each will be awarded. PSR/Sacramento reserves the option of also providing additional scholarship awards if the scholarship selection committee deems that there are more than 10 deserving applicants and if PSR/Sacramento's scholarship fund permits.
  - Students chosen as scholarship recipients will be notified by email by Monday, April 27, 2026. Scholarship checks will be mailed to students within 5 business days of the date that the student acknowledges the notification.
